Exhibition Concept

Theatre People (noun)

Organic beings that require collaboration to create. Skilled in problem-solving and value cooperation and communication. They either shine under the spotlight or contribute in the shadows, but sharing applause selflessly. They yearn to reunite with other theatre people, continuously radiating brilliance in their habitat.

In this virtual and intimate network era, the theatre is the habitat for rare species-- Theatre people and their audiences. They adhere to the promise of a ticket, anticipating the shared breaths on and off stage, and creating each unique, unrepeatable encounter.

Comparing to other forms of art, theatre art is the physical co-presence of creators and audiences, whose interactions construct each unique performance. In an age of mass digital reproduction, a group of artists performs their magic before the audience, whose immediate reactions—be it indifference, surprise, enthusiasm, or resistance—feedback into the performance, influencing subsequent creations. This "ancient" form of communication is still carefully preserved by the theatre.

Nowadays, theatre people, who rely on organic collaboration, face the challenges of

dispersal due to migration and the shrinking space for creation. How do they view their identity as theatre people, both in the past and present? How do they interpret their relationship with the theatre, their habitat?

Suie graduated from the Department of Sociology at Hong Kong Baptist University and the Graduate Institute of Arts Administration and Management at Taipei National University of the Arts. She has extensive experience in art education and children's education. She has served as a theatre producer, the convener of FIGMENT HK Interactive Art Festival, a curator and coordinator of art education and community art projects, and a planner for international exchange platforms. Additionally, she is an audio describer and instructor, providing Cantonese audio description support for the elderly and visually impaired.

In 2022, Suie relocated from Hong Kong to Melbourne. She is currently the host of the Cantonese children's podcast "Muggle-Tingo-Tango" and a resident creator at Drips Creation (Hong Kong), as well as a core member of Cantobee (Melbourne), an initiative dedicated to storytelling for children.

● 展覽概念

劇場人(名詞)

有機生命體,需群聚創作。擅解難題,着重合作溝通。或在鎂光燈下閃耀,或在黑暗中輸送力量,卻不分彼此地分享掌聲。每次創作也與其他劇場人重新組合,不間斷地在棲息地發出 光芒。

在這個虛擬親密的網絡世代,劇場是稀有生物的棲息地。他們 - 劇場人和劇場觀眾共同遵守 一張門票的約定,期待在舞台上下的同呼同吸,共同創造每一場無法複製的一期一會。

劇場 Theatre Art 與其他藝術的分別之一,是劇場在物理上把創作者和觀眾困在一起,台上、台下的互動,共同建構每一場表演獨特的相遇。在大量複製的數碼年代,一群藝術創作者在觀眾面前展現藝術的魔法,而觀眾最直接的反應—不論是冷漠、驚訝、狂熱、反抗等等——也透過表演當下的回饋給台上表演者,而影響着接續下來的創作。這種「古老」的溝通方式,仍然被劇場穩妥地保存着。

如今,依賴有機地組合的劇場人,面對使他們散落四周的移民潮,以及創作空間愈益收窄的生態,在過去與現在,他們如果看待自己身為劇場人的身份?對於劇場這片棲息地和自己的關係又如何演繹?

● 計劃書呈現方式

建議空間:一條到盡頭的走廊,或空間角落

呈現效果: 參觀者像進入一條隧道或者山洞, 探究洞內的稀有品種

方式:

用黑色大卡紙/黑布組合成一個外寬內窄的隧道,隧道盡頭擺放一個小木箱(建議是黑色/深木色,像舞台),上面放了一件只有手掌大小的黑色 T 恤,T 恤上面寫着:「Theatre People」。旁邊的小卡片模擬博物館的物種標示,印有計劃畫第一段「劇場人(名詞)」。完整的紙本計劃書掛在或擺放在隧道口,亦可以改以 OR Code 形式展示。
